PANSY also known as "Hearts-Ease" stands for service and friendship

guide, a goal, it will show the way


CARDINAL known for its whistle "Good Cheer!"


HAWAIIAN LEI symbol for the circle of friendship


PINE TREE
Symbol for boldness, loyalty, and stability.


UNICORN symbol of chastity, purity


CLOVER LEAF traditional symbol of good luck, also the shape of the GS trefoil pin.


LIGHTNING symbol of power of nature


PURPLE VIOLET symbolic today of clean environment and clean earth


WATERFALL symbol of preservation, redemption, cleansing


DAFFODIL spring
flower, symbol of a
sunny personality


LILY OF THE
VALLEY symbol of purity - in folk lore it is known as fairy bells


RED ROSE the "All American" flower, symbol of beauty


WHITE ROSE
symbol of the royal house of Stuart.
Stand for loyalty and challenge (also the crest of the first Girl Scout Troop in Savannah, Georgia)


DOGWOOD
symbolic of Christians of the resurrection


MORNING
GLORY symbolizes the awakening of a new day and glory to God


SAILBOAT symbol for free as the wind


WILD ROSE
Cherokee rose found in hidden places that take an explorer to find it


FALLING STAR symbol of good luck - make wishes come true


MUSIC NOTES international symbol for music or song


SEASHELL symbolizes gifts from the sea

In the early days of Girl Scouting, troop crests were used to identify a troop. The rapid growth of the movement soon made numbering necessary, but crests were kept as a symbol of a troop's goal or main interest.

Today's troops should think carefully about the crest they choose. It should have a special meaning to them, one they can pass along to new members each year. The symbol can be used on a troop flag or to mark troop equipment. Every member should know what their crest is and what it means. There are 23 crests available and one blank crest for troops wishing to embroider an original design.
